100% raw virgin human hair with an ultra-thin 0.5 cm seam. Lies flat against the scalp for a seamless, undetectable blend. Compatible with beaded and sew-in methods — volume and length without bulk, suitable for all hair types.

How Much Hair Do I Need?

| Amount | Wefts | Effect | Best For |
|--------|---------|----------------------------|-------------------------------|
| 50g | 1 weft | Subtle fill & blend | Thin areas, crown top-ups |
| 100g | 2 wefts | Noticeable length & volume | Medium density, full coverage |

|------|---------|------------------------------|-----------------------------------|
| 150g | 3 wefts | Significant volume boost | Thick hair, added length |
| 200g | 4 wefts | Full dramatic transformation | Short / coarse hair, major length |

Tip: Always leave a 1–2 cm shadow zone along the hairline. Never place wefts flush to the hairline or part — keeps bonds hidden and prevents scalp tension.

Step-by-Step Installation

BEADED WEFT METHOD · SEW-IN METHOD · NO HEAT · NO GLUE



01 Section the Hair

Take a triangular section about half an inch wide. Release a clean horizontal parting and clip the upper layer away.



02 Start Beading

Thread silicone-lined micro beads onto a loop tool. Space beads every 1 inch across the row for even tension.



03 Secure with Pliers

Hold bead 0.5–1.0 inch from scalp. Use professional pliers to clamp and flatten each bead firmly.



04 Position the Weft

Lay the flat weft over the bead row. Align the ultra-thin 0.5 cm seam flush against the scalp.



05 Loop the Hair

Loop natural hair over the weft. After each loop, go right over the bead and over again to lock the weft.



06 Cut the Thread

Once the row is secured, cut the thread cleanly at each end — flush to the last bead, no loose ends.



07 Prepare to Sew

For sew-in method: thread a curved needle. Stitch the weft along the bead row at even 1-inch intervals.



08 Start with a Knot

Begin sew-in with a secure anchor knot at the row start. This prevents loosening throughout wear.



09 Cut Thread & Finish

After the final stitch, make a closing knot. Cut thread close to the knot. Row should lay flat and smooth.

Tools Required

| Tool | Purpose | Tool | Purpose |

| Flat Weft Extension Pieces | Color-matched; cut to width along seam before application | Silicone-Lined Micro Beads | Secures hair and weft without heat or glue |
| Loop / Threading Needle | Pulls natural hair through micro beads cleanly | Professional Extension Pliers | Clamps and flattens beads for a secure, lasting hold |

Note: No heat or glue is applied to natural hair — only the micro bead is compressed. For sew-in, braids are the anchor. Professional installation recommended for best results.

Care & Aftercare Guide

Sulfate-Free Shampoo

Wash 2–3x/week; deep condition mid-lengths and ends only — keep oils away from the seam.

Heat Styling

Curl or straighten freely under 160°C (320°F) with heat protectant.

Color & Bleach

Raw human hair takes color beautifully — professional color-match recommended.

Blow-Dry / Air-Dry

Air-dry when possible; medium heat (100–120°C) near the seam is safe.

Daily Maintenance

- Keep conditioner and oils away from weft seam
- Use a loop brush only — detangle from ends upward
- Sleep in a loose braid on a silk/satin pillowcase
- Brush thoroughly after wearing hats

Removal & Move-Up

Beaded: open bead with pliers, slide weft free — no solvents or damage. Sew-in: cut thread carefully. Move-up every 6–8 weeks.

Flat Weft vs Other Wefts

Frequently Asked Questions

Smooth vs double-stitched flat weft?

Same raw hair quality. Smooth top = flatter and more seamless. Double-stitched top = thicker and more durable for longer wear.

Can I cut the flat weft?

Yes — cut along the seam to any width without shedding.

Which installation method is best?

Micro rings (beaded) for damage-free install. Sew-in cornrows for stronger hold on thicker hair.

How long do they last?

2–3 years total with proper care; plan a professional move-up every 6–8 weeks.

Can I color or heat style?

Yes — 100% raw human hair can be curled, straightened, colored and washed freely under 160°C.

How much hair do I need?

100g–200g (2–4 wefts) for a full head. 50g works for subtle fill-ins or crown top-ups.
